Want to protect your patch of remnant bush but need some financial assistance?

The Moore Catchment Council has money available through the Northern Agricultural Catchments Council to help fund projects to fence off native woodland in the Moore River catchment.

Rachel Walmsley of MCC says 'Fencing off remnant vegetation on private land is so important for conserving native flora and fauna especially threatened species like Carnaby's Black Cockatoo.

We can offer farmers between **\$2,500** - **\$3,000km** for locking up and protecting their bush, providing the project meets minimum criteria and passes the site assessment.'

The first come-first served limited funding has been provided by the Federal Government and will be available until **December 2012**. Rachel added 'We have already allocated half the money available so if you're interested then get in quick!' Please phone Rachel or Ingrid at MCC on **9653 1355** for more information about this incentive program, and also incentives for planting **perennial grasses**, **tagasaste**, **saltbush**, **oil mallees**, **sandalwood**, **brushwood and mixed native blocks**.
