Also known as: Statice

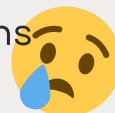
About

- Native to Mediterranean and central Asia.
- Clumping plants with upright stems with white, pink, yellow, blue and purple papery flowers.
- Flowers with tiny purple flowers in loose spreading spikelets.



Need to know

- Invades relatively intact native vegetation, especially the margins of saline wetlands.
- A prolific seeder.
- Widespread on wasteland, roadsides and disturbed vegetation, especially on margins of saline soils.

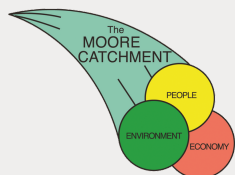

PULL IT OUT

- Pull out any time of year.
- Destroy flowers and seed.



SPOT SPRAY

Read the manufacturers' labels and material safety data sheets before spraying.

- Wipe with 100% glyphosate when actively growing/flowering.
- Apply in spring/summer.
