

Moora Eucalypt Tree Trail

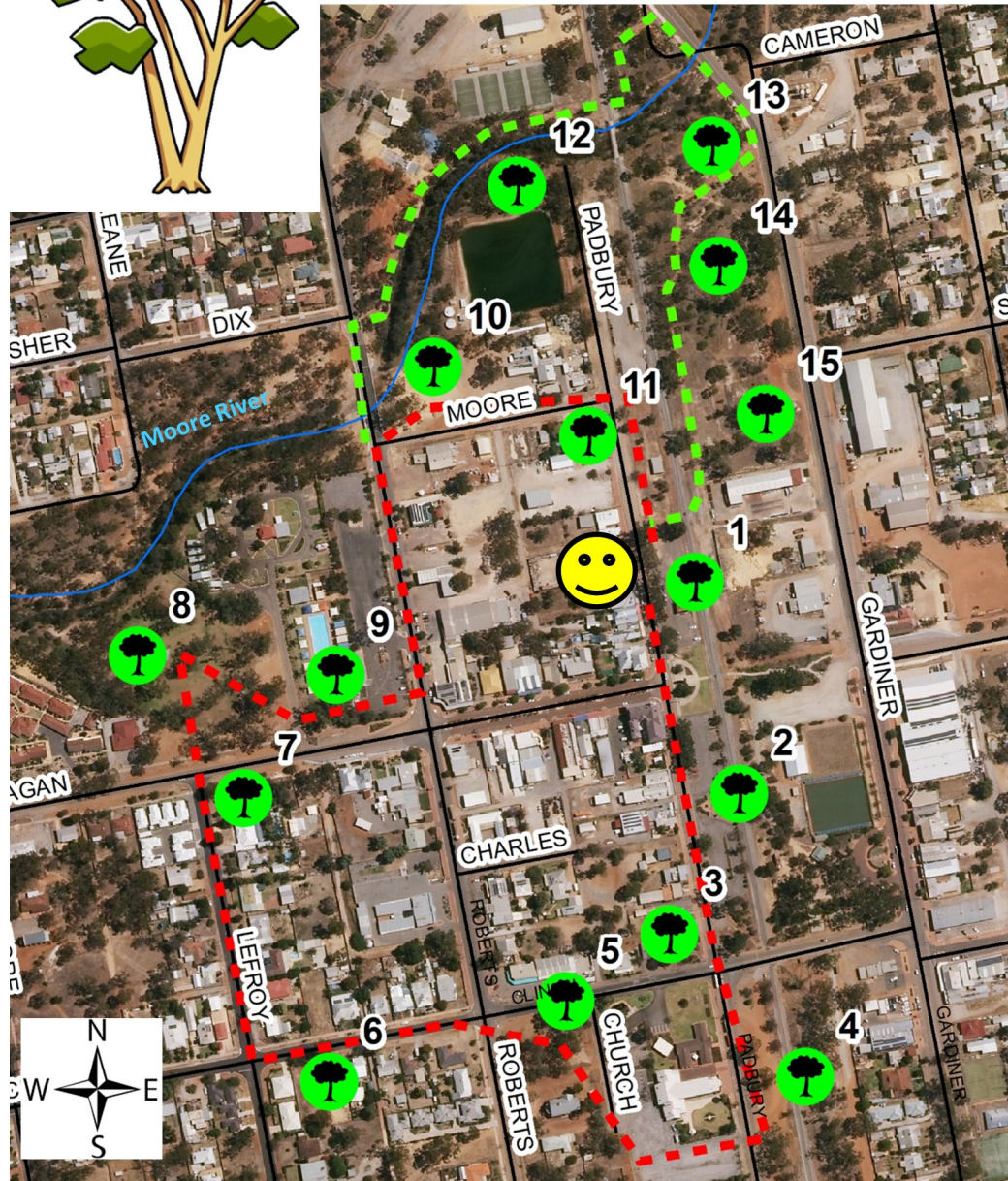


Enjoy a walk amongst the native Eucalypt trees



Start at Moora Visitors Centre. Head south, follow map.

2. *Eucalyptus leucoxydon rosea* (Red Flowering Gum) & *Eucalyptus albopurpurea* (Port Lincoln Mallee)
3. *Eucalyptus macrocarpa* (Mottlecah)
4. *Eucalyptus salmonophloia* (Salmon Gum)
5. *Eucalyptus wandoo* (Wandoo) and *Eucalyptus salmonophloia* (Salmon Gum)
6. Huge *Eucalyptus camaldulensis* (River Red Gum)
7. *Eucalyptus salmonophloia* (Salmon Gum)
8. Apex Park featuring various Eucalypts
9. *Eucalyptus camaldulensis* (River Red Gum)
10. *Eucalyptus salmonophloia* (Salmon Gum)
11. *Eucalyptus woodwardii* (Lemon Flowering Gum)
12. *Eucalyptus loxophleba* (York Gum)
13. *Eucalyptus salmonophloia* (Salmon Gum)
14. *Eucalyptus rudis* (Flooded Gum) avenue
15. *Eucalyptus salmonophloia* (Salmon Gum)



Main walk - - - - **2km** Mainly flat Bitumen walking

Extra walk - - - - **1km** Uneven gravel track walking
